DISTRICT OF LILLOOET BURNING BAN

Due to the hot and dry weather we have been experiencing, the Lillooet Fire Department, in accordance with District of Lillooet Fire & Safety Regulation Bylaw No. 202, 2004, has issued a complete Burning Ban effective within the municipal boundaries beginning Wednesday, July 16th at 12 noon

This ban covers ALL fires, including those for cooking, backyard fire pits and fires for ceremonial purposes. *All Campgrounds are included in this ban.*

Stoves and portable campfires are allowed at this time. A portable campfire apparatus is a freestanding fireplace that burns liquid or gaseous fuel designed to provide ambiance and heat. The flame is usually open to the elements but may have grating to assist with cooking food.

An outdoor stove is a device that uses liquid or gaseous fuel, or briquettes, and is manufactured for the purpose of heating or cooking. It does not include a fire vented through a structure that has a flue and is incorporated in a building. Maximum flame length of not more than 15 cm. **THESE DEVICES MUST BE CSA APPROVED.**
