2018 District of Lillooet General Local Election

Casual, Non-Union

Do you enjoy working with the public and supporting a team? The District of Lillooet is currently looking for election workers to facilitate voting in the 2018 Municipal Election on October 20, 2018.

Positions Available

Registration Officers: responsible for registering Resident and Non-Resident Electors, verifying identifications, explaining the voting process, issuing ballots and assisting with the ballot counting.

Traffic Officers: responsible for removing campaign signage from within 100m of the voting place, directing voters to the registration table, directing voters from the voting booths to the ballot boxes, making sure voters leave the voting area after they vote and assisting with the ballot counting.

Employment Eligibility

- Be 18 years of age or older;
- Be eligible to work in Canada;
- Be responsible for their own transportation to and from the voting place;
- Attend a mandatory training session the first week of October;
- Not be related to any candidate running for office in the general election;
- Not be actively working for any election campaign or any candidate; and
- Be available to work extended hours on Election Day – Saturday, October 20, 2018.

Work Dates

Mandatory Training Session:

- Held between October 1, 2018 and October 5, 2018

Optional Advanced Voting Day:

- October 10, 2018

Mandatory Election Day:

- October 20, 2018

Pay Rate

Election Workers will be paid \$14/hour.
