

## **CAYOOSH CREEK CAMPGROUND – GUIDELINES FOR STURGEON ANGLERS FOR 2020**

### **Guidelines for Non-Commercial Anglers and Boaters**

- Use of boat launch for non-commercial boaters is restricted to residents of the District of Lillooet and residents of the area bounded by the Squamish-Lillooet Regional District Areas A & B only. Proof of residency may be requested at the time of contact with the campground operator.
- Boaters and Anglers must phone or text the Campground Contractor at 250-256-9034 to schedule a time to access the boat launch and provide an expected time of return. Boaters must provide a contact name and phone number and an emergency contact number.
- The Contractor will meet the Boaters at the Front Gate at the scheduled time to provide access through the campground.
- Boaters must proceed through the campground to the boat launch parking area without stopping within the campground.
- Access to the boat launch area will be restricted with a chain and programmed lock. Boaters will be provided with the code for this lock.
- Boaters must proceed to the launch area and, once they have launched, must return their truck and trailer to the parking area inside the gate. Boaters must close and re-lock the chain gate before putting their boat out onto the river.
- Boaters should remain in the parking and launch area. They should not enter the campground area and/or interact with other campground guests.
- Boaters must dispose of their own refuse safely and off the campground property. They are prohibited from disposing of any refuse in the campground dumpster.
- Boaters are reminded that campground washrooms are closed.
- Upon their exit, boaters must lock the chain gate behind them.
- If the campground operator is not available when they reach the Front Gate, boaters must contact her by calling or texting 250-256-9034 to be let out of the campground.
- There will be no access through or exit from the campground outside of the operating hours of 8:00 AM to 10:00 PM.
