Public Notice is given to the electors of the District of Lillooet that, nominations for the offices of:

School Trustee (*One Position*)

For the remainder of a four-year term, which commenced December 2014 and will end Fall 2018, will be received by the Chief Election Officer or a designated person, as follows:

Nomination forms are available at the District of Lillooet Municipal Office during regular office hours of 8:30 am to 4:30 pm (closed between 12:00 pm and 1:00 pm), Monday to Friday, excluding Statutory Holidays, from March 7, 2017 to the close of the nomination period on March 17, 2017 at 4:00 pm or online at www.lillooetbc.ca.

QUALIFICATIONS FOR OFFICE

A person is qualified to be nominated, elected, and to hold office as a member of local government if they meet the following criteria:

- Canadian citizen;
- 18 years of age or older on general voting day, April 22, 2017.
- resident of British Columbia for at least 6 months immediately before the day nomination papers are filed;
- not disqualified under the *Local Government Act* or any other enactment from being nominated for, being elected to or holding the office, or be otherwise disqualified by law.
- fully intend to accept the office if elected
- the information provided in the nomination documents is true
- aware of and understand the requirements and restrictions of the Local Elections Campaign Financing Act and fully intend to comply with those requirements and restrictions
