District of Lillooet RFP 2018-01 Supply of Garbage Pickup Services

The Respondent will provide a proposal detailing their suggested solution(s) as to how solid waste (garbage) can be picked up in Lillooet and disposed of. The proposal will detail two main options: 1) Respondent to provide solid waste services to half of the District (approximately 500 accounts), and 2) Respondent to provide solid waste services to the entire District. The proposal will show total cost to the District for each option.

The District of Lillooet (DoL) currently has 1,024 paid residential garbage accounts. Approximately half are presently picked up by District staff and half are picked up by a Contractor on a weekly basis. Note that one property may have multiple accounts (duplex, strata with several townhouses, mobile home park).

The map (see Map in attachments) shows the number of paid accounts in various areas of the District. Each account is to have solid waste picked up once per week. District crews currently service areas A, B, C, D1, part of D4, D6, and F. The current Contractor services areas D2, D3, part of D4, D5, E, G, and H.

The District does not feel that standardized garbage totes would be feasible in Lillooet due to the steep grades on many properties (see Photos in attachments) and the elderly population that exists here (2016 Census, people over 65, Lillooet 23.5%, Canada 16.9%). No provisions have been made in the District of Lillooet 2018 budget to purchase garbage totes.

There is a Regional District Landfill within the boundaries of the District of Lillooet, located at 405 Landfill Rd. The Respondent is responsible to ensure their proposal includes tipping fees at this or another approved landfill location.
