2017 PROPERTY TAX NOTICES HAVE BEEN MAILED

Property Owners (especially new owners) who have not received their property tax notice by May 19, 2017 should contact the District of Lillooet office at (250) 256-4289.

WHETHER OR NOT YOU RECEIVE A TAX NOTICE, IT IS YOUR RESPONSIBILITY AS THE PROPERTY OWNER TO PAY THE TAXES BY THE DUE DATE OF JULY 4th, 2017 TO AVOID A PENALTY.

- To help avoid waiting in line at the municipal office, you are encouraged to pay your taxes early.
- Post-dated cheques and partial payments are welcome.
- Payment is accepted at the municipal office located at 615 Main Street Monday to Friday, from 8:30am to 12:00pm and from 1:00pm to 4:30pm, except statutory holidays. Payments can also be made online through your bank's online bill payment service.
- Payments can be mailed to PO Box 610 Lillooet, BC V0K 1V0.
- **POSTMARKS ARE NOT ACCEPTED AS PROOF OF PAYMENT.** Payment must be received in the District office on, or before, July 4th, 2017.
- **PROVINCIAL HOME OWNER GRANT** – If you are eligible, please ensure that the bottom of your tax notice is **COMPLETED** and **SIGNED** and returned to the District office on, or before, July 4th, 2017. If you are 65 years of age or older, please ensure that you include your birthdate. Also, if your property taxes are paid by your mortgage company, you still need to claim the home owner grant if you are eligible.
- The Provincial Home Owner Grant must be claimed **EACH YEAR** that you are eligible.
- To avoid a penalty on your Provincial Home Owner Grant, it must be claimed, if you are eligible, even if no payment on your taxes is made or if you are unable to pay the entire amount owing.

A LATE PAYMENT PENALTY OF 10% WILL BE ADDED TO ALL UNPAID BALANCES INCLUDING UNCLAIMED PROVINCIAL HOME OWNER GRANTS AT THE CLOSE OF BUSINESS ON JULY 4th, 2017.
